



#### What is the D8 Visa?

All you need to know

The D8 Visa, also known as the digital nomad visa or remote worker visa, is an alternative route to obtain Portuguese Residency for those who can perform a professional activity from Portugal.

## D8 privileges

#### Applicants are entitled to:

- Reside in Portugal and reunite with family members.
- Work and access public schools and universities.
- Access the Portuguese Social Security System, including the National Health System.
- Utilize the courts of law and have access to Portuguese laws.

#### Who can apply?

Non-EU/EEA/Swiss citizens engaging in remote subordinate or independent professional activities outside Portugal's National Territory.





# Requirements

- Obtain a Portuguese tax number (NIF)
- Open a Portuguese bank account
- Provide proof of means of subsistence
- Provide proof of long-term accomodation in Portugal.
- Obtain a valid travel insurance for the duration of the visa as stipulated by the Consulate/Embassy
- Have a clean criminal record

# Validity and future opportunities

What can you expect?

The **minimum stay** requirement mandates that individuals do not exceed 6 consecutive or 8 nonconsecutive months outside the country during the validity of each temporary permit. However, residence permits will not be cancelled for citizens absent longer if they can prove engagement in professional, business, social, or cultural activities abroad.

After a minimum of 5 years, applicants may seek a

Permanent Residence Permit, requiring proficiency in

Portuguese, a Portuguese address, and a clean criminal record. Alternatively, they can apply for Portuguese citizenship, with similar requirements.


